**SECURITY SUGGESTIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS FOR 2021**

1. Continue with two shifts of two guards – 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM and 5:00 PM to 1:00 AM.
  
2. The need for better enforcement of unauthorized vehicles on the beach parking lot. I suggest that POW obtain five wheel locks (boots). They cost \$60 each, and will be paid for with the collection of one removal fee for each. This will allow enforcement for non-stickered vehicle enforcement where we currently have no means of enforcement. The removal fee (to be determined) can be enforced by Rick and the Security Commissioner. There will be signage warning of the booting and that should act as the deterrent to improper parking.
  
3. The need for better enforcement of underage golf cart driving. I suggest use of the current Ordinance remedy of suspension of golf cart privileges for one year after two violations/warnings.
  
4. The need to computerize and better organize the golf cart numbering and registration process. Helen says that we can include this in the POW Quick Books program to link the golf cart registrations to the owners' accounts. We also need to have better enforcement of un-numbered and un-stickered golf carts as well as rental golf carts. I suggest the use of a volunteer golf cart monitor as was done this year.
  
5. The need to be able to enforce the no eating and no drinking on the beach as well as improper behavior by young people at night. Currently, the guards do not have an effective means of enforcement. We need a culture change.
  
6. The need to be able to better enforce stop sign violations by golf carts and vehicles. Suggestions are needed as to how best to do this.
