GOLF CART RULES AND REGULATIONS

DEFINITION: A GOLF CART IS DEFINED AS A LOW SPEED FOUR-WHEELED VEHICLE DESIGNED AND BUILT SPECIFICALLY FOR USE ON A GOLF COURSE CAPABLE OF SPEEDS UP TO 20 MPH IN AN UNMODIFIED STATE. NO OTHER RECREATIONAL VEHICLE TYPES ARE ALLOWED (POLARIS, ATV'S, ETC)

It is the responsibility of the golf cart owner to conform with all pertinent Laws regarding the use and operation of a golf cart, including but not limited to insurance, liability, registration and vehicle requirements. It is the responsibility of the golf cart owner to understand all local, state and federal laws pertaining to golf cart use and operation. It is recommended that you contact your insurance professional and discuss what insurance coverage is available to you.

REGISTRATION

- Annual
 - Completed Registration Form, Release of Liability (Hold Harmless), Proof of Liability Insurance and payment of annual fee.
 - Required for owners and renters of golf carts registering for use on POW roads..

INSPECTION

- All Golf Carts must be equipped with the following (no exceptions):
 - Locking Brake
 - Main Power Switch
 - Headlights
 - Brake Lights
 - Turn Signals
 - Windshield
 - Front and rear reflectors
 - Horn

- Rearview Mirror
- ID number on each side of the golf care and a current decal (issued upon successful inspection)

OPERATION

- Restricted to operators with a valid and current motor vehicle operators license. NO LEARNER PERMITS.
- **Must adhere to all State and Local regulations in accordance with Connecticut General Statue Section 14-300g, P.A. 09-187 and Section 14-227a.**
- Golf Cart Operators will be held fully responsible for any and all damages that are caused by the use or misuse of the golf cart by the Operator or their guests.
- NO towing of any items or objects.
- Golf carts must adhere to all parking regulations set forth by POW.
- Permission to operate a privately-owned golf cart within the POW is a non-transferable and non-assignable personal privilege.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH RULES AND REULATIONS

Violators of the Rules and Regulations will be subject to the following:

- Traffic citations for moving violations.
- Booting for improper parking.
- After one warning about underage driving, suspension of use privileges in POW for the remainder of the season.
